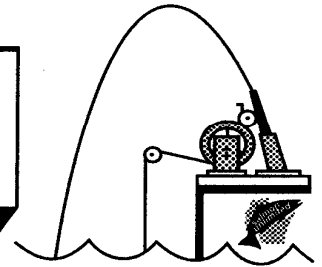

Salmon Unlimited Fish Outing Regulations for 2011

1. All Boats & Individuals from shore must register before fishing.
 2. Registration can be done by phone, marine radio(68), or online @ www.salmonunlimitedwisconsin.com
 3. All Boats in the event **can leave at any time** but must leave and return to Racine by water.
 4. Fishing hours are from 5:00 am to 11:30 am **Must be in Weigh in line by 12:00 (noon):**
 - A. **Outing #2(June 4th)** – matches “SU Opener” (5:00 am to 1:00 pm) w/30 min run time
 - B. **Outing #5(Sept.12)** - 6am -1pm
 5. There shall be no registration fee. Non-members can fish up to two club outings before joining the club.
 6. The following species are eligible: Chinook & Coho Salmon, Brown, Rainbow, & Lake Trout.
All fish weighed in must be at least 16 inches in length.
 7. Two divisions exist: Boat division and Shore division.(Off-shore & On-shore)
 8. **Boat Division Specific Rules:**
 - A. **DNR rules apply;** 3 rods per person (9 rod max.), 5 fish per person.
 - B. **Weigh in;** Up to 10 fish per boat to the scale.
Note: No culling or sorting at the scale will be allowed!
Fish may be kept up to the legal DNR limit per angler. **Only 4 Lake Trout may be weighed in.**
 - C. **Scoring:**
 - a. **10 points per fish**
 - b. **50 bonus points if all 5 species are weighed in**
 - c. **1 point per pound**
 9. **Shore Division Specific Rules:**
 - A. **DNR rules apply;** 3 rods per person, 5 fish per person.
 - B. **Weigh in;** Up to 5 fish to the scale.
 - C. **Scoring:**
 - a. **10 points per fish**
 - b. **50 points if you land 4 species**
 - c. **1 point per pound**
 10. Forfeiture of all points will occur for any citations received. This includes civil, DNR, Coast Guard citations or un-sportsmanlike behavior. **The Fishing Committee** will judge un-sportsmanlike behavior on an individual basis.
 11. **Three of the Five Outings will Count towards Boat of the Year Standings**
 12. If you have a boat breakdown, Captain & Crew may fish in a different boat, but the Captain & Crew must be registered that way **In Advance.**
 13. If you have a boat breakdown on the water, you must notify a fishing committee member **prior to noon**
You must be in the weigh in line by 2:00 pm. Prizes may be previously awarded by the discretion of the **Fishing Committee.**
 14. **Boat of the day & Top Individual from Shore division** will discuss winning tactics after the outing weigh in and top award announcements.
 15. **The fishing committee** will decide if we need to cancel the outing due to weather and conditions. A decision may be made the night before the outing, but an announcement will be made at 4:30 am and broadcast on channel 68. In the event that we have a delay to the start of the outing, fishing will begin ½ hour after the decision is made to go fishing.
This applies to both Divisions!!!
- P.S.** Captains, if you are registered to fish, then the club is making it your responsibility to **Check Back In!**
This is for everyone’s safety. We don’t want to make this a rule with penalties because we are a family orientated club with fun outings.
- P.P.S.** Salmon Unlimited is not responsible or liable in any way for injuries or damage to boats while participating in any Club Outings. We encourage responsible boat handling and safe fishing Techniques. Good luck and good fishing.

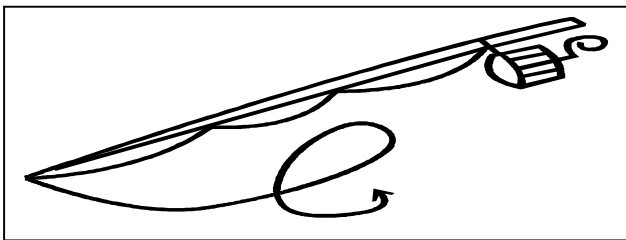
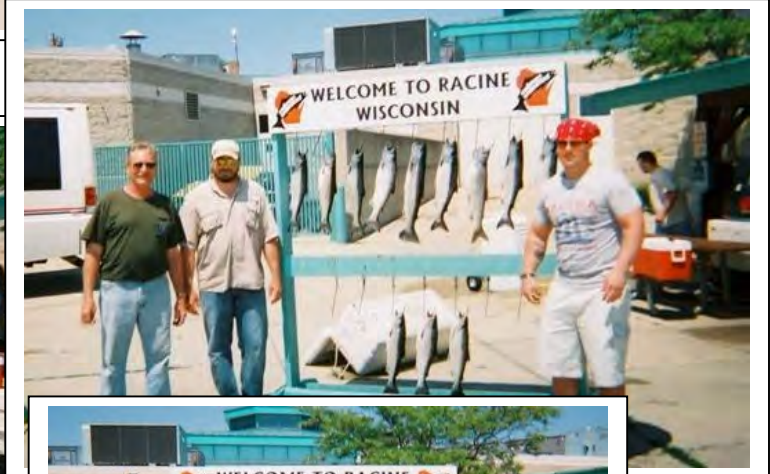
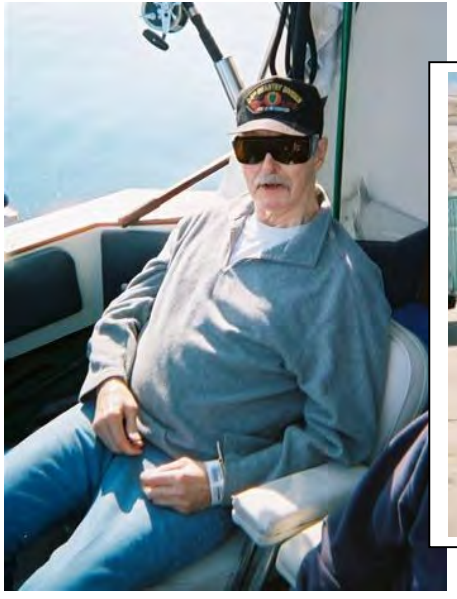
****New Business-**Attendance raffle for March winner was David Hasselburg, not present
