

## **BIG FISH AWARDS**

Embroidered award patches will be given to S.U. Wisconsin members whose fish meet or exceed the trophy weight requirements as follows:

Coho Salmon . . . . .	8 lbs.	Brown Trout . . . . .	8 lbs.
Chinook Salmon . . . . .	22 lbs.	Lake Trout . . . . .	9 lbs.
Rainbow/Steelhead . . . . .	8 lbs.		

These fish are also eligible for Master Angler Award Patch.

### **RULES:**

1. Only ACTIVE members and their families of Salmon Unlimited Wisconsin are eligible.
2. A PHOTOGRAPH of the fish entry is REQUIRED.
3. All fish must be taken on rod, reel, and line with either live bait or artificial lures. Intentional snagging or foul-hooking is not permitted.
4. All fish must be taken during legal open season by entrant according to local state regulations.
5. Fish must be weighed on an accurate scale and there must be at least one witness to the weigh-in.
6. Entry forms must be completed in full. Incomplete entries are subject to disqualification.
7. Deliberate falsification of an entry may be grounds for suspension from SALMON UNLIMITED WISCONSIN.
8. All entries, including photographs, become the property of SALMON UNLIMITED WISCONSIN.
9. In addition to award patches, trophies will be awarded for each of the five largest species eligible. These trophies will be presented on the basis of submitted and approved applications for the award patches.
10. Trophies will be awarded on the basis of weight. In case of ties, length and girth will be used to determine winner.
11. If there is not entry for a particular species over the minimum weight requirement, that trophy will not be awarded for that season.
12. All fish caught must be registered within 60 days after caught. (This rule is required so that information will be fresh in the mind of the entrant.)
13. Entries may be turned in at regular meetings or mailed to S.U. WISCONSIN Awards Committee, Box 081333, Racine, WI 53408.
14. Contest ends the second Wednesday of November. This is a meeting night.
15. A coveted Master Angler Award Patch will be given to any member who in one season catches all five (5) of the above fish meeting or exceeding the required weights.
