OFFICIAL RULES

I. ENTRY FEE

- A. The fee is \$100 per boat and payments must be received prior to July 23, 7 PM
- B. Entry fees are non-refundable after July 23, 7 PM, except in the event of the cancellation of the tournament due to weather or other reasons beyond the control of the Tournament
- C. Make payment due to "Salmon Unlimited of Wisconsin".

II. PRIZES

- A. Cash prizes will be awarded to the top 25 boats entered based on the following percentages of total entry fees. The number in parentheses indicates the dollars to be awarded assuming 100 boats entered.
 - 1st Place 25% \$2,500
 - 2nd Place 10% \$1,000
 - 3rd Place 7.5% \$750
 - 4th Place 5% \$500
 - 5th Place 3.5% \$350
 - 6th Place 2.5% \$250
 - 7th Place 2% \$200
 - 8th Place 1.5% \$150
 - 9th Place 1.5% \$150
 - 10th Place 1.5% \$150
 - 11th thru 25th Place 1% \$100
- B. In case of ties, the prize money between the two or more places the participants would have won will be divided equally between the tied contestants.
- C. 10 AM Early Limit Award – first boat in will be awarded \$100.
- D. Cash On The Line is part of the Southeast WI Challenge Series; a portion of the prize money will be contributed to the point fund.

III. SCORING

- A. All winners will be determined by the Tournament Committee, and their decision will be final.
- B. Winners will be determined on the total accumulation of points. Points will be assigned as ten points per fish and one point per pound.
- C. The following species shall be eligible.
 - COHO SALMON CHINOOK SALMON
 - BROWN TROUT STEELHEAD OR RAINBOW TROUT
 - LAKE TROUT ATLANTIC SALMON

IV. BOAT IDENTIFICATION

- A. The Tournament Committee will furnish to each boat a identification number and flag.
- B. The boat identification number must be permanently displayed on the Starboard side of the participant's boat at all times during the contest. The flag must be displayed on the radio antenna or similar elevated device.

V. DATES AND HOURS

- A. The tournament will be held on July 24. Rain date will be July 25
- B. The tournament schedule will be as follows:
- C. July 23 – Captain's Meeting at 7:00 PM
Location: Outside Salmon-A-Rama weigh-in facility.
- D. July 24- Fishing Period: 5:00 A.M. to 1:00 PM
- E. Each boat and crew must have at least one member in attendance at the Captain's Meeting.
- F. The contest will be considered official if a total of three (3) hours are fished.

VI. START AND FINISH

- A. All boats must leave Racine harbor by water.
- B. All boats must be in the water and must visually check in with the Tournament Official prior to the official start.
- C. Check in will begin at approximately 4:15 AM.
- D. All boats must leave Racine by water at 5:00 AM or when tournament committee deems it safe to leave. Fishing may start immediately
- E. The official start of the contest will be made from the Committee Boat or Contest Headquarters at 5:00 AM.
- F. Each boat must be within the designated holding area prior to the end of the Contest (1:00 PM). Each boat must visually check with the Tournament Officials as they enter the holding area.
- G. Once boats have checked back in with the tournament committee, they may return to boat slip or trailer.
- H. All boats must have a crew member and their fish in the weigh-in line by 1:45 PM.

VII. GENERAL FISHING RULES

- A. There will be a maximum of nine (9) baits in the water at any one time, with no more than nine lures in use. Dodgers, attractors, or other similar hookless devices do not count as lures.
- B. All fish entered must be caught on hook and line in accordance with the Wisconsin laws. No meat line or other similar device may be attached to any part of the boat or downrigger.
- C. FISH may be released when caught. If it determined to release a fish, it must be returned to the lake immediately.
- D. There are no distance limits as to where a tournament boat may fish as long as all traveling is done on the water.
- E. All fish kept must be logged on the fish log sheet.
- F. Each boat may keep a 3 man limit of trout and salmon per DNR Rules (6 Lake Trout).
- G. Once this limit is reached, each boat must proceed immediately to the weigh-in.
- H. Each boat may weigh in up to 12 fish from their catch.
- I. Channel 68 is the official radio channel.
